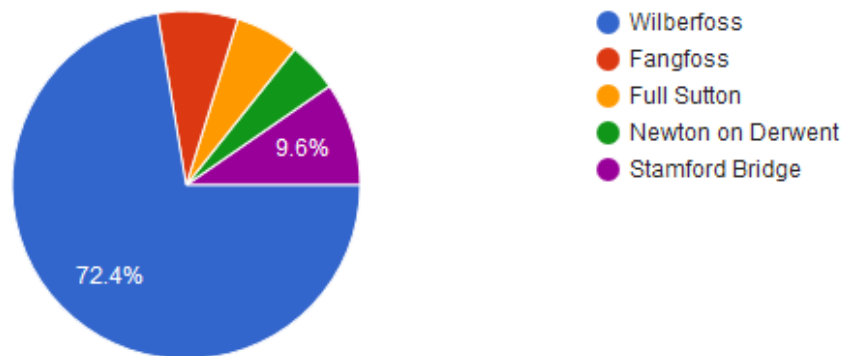

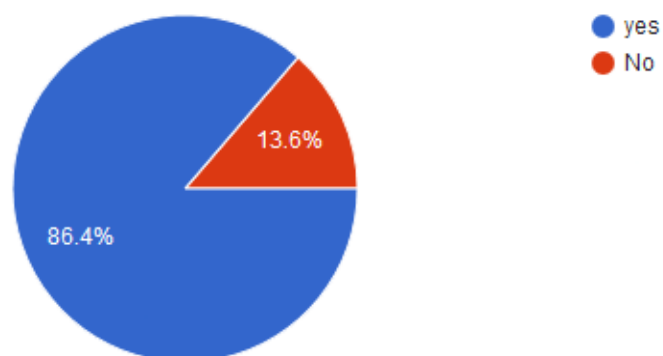
Are you a resident of Wilberfoss or surrounding villages?

322 responses



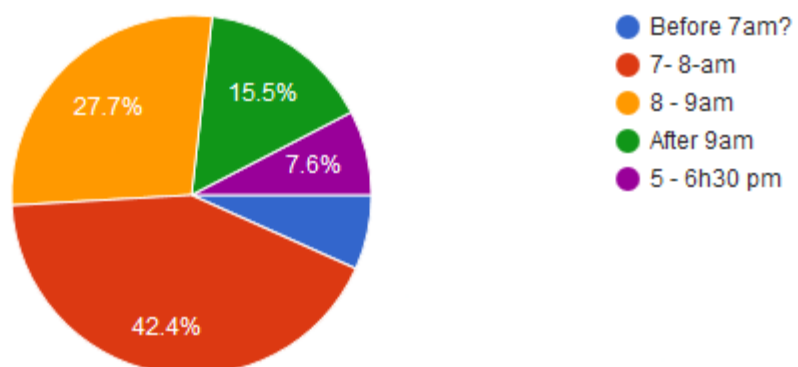
Do you use the A1079 to commute to / from work?

330 responses



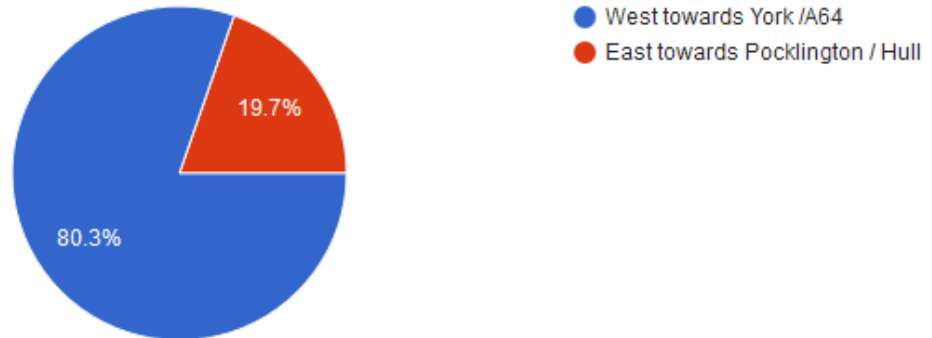
What time do you usually use the A1079?

328 responses



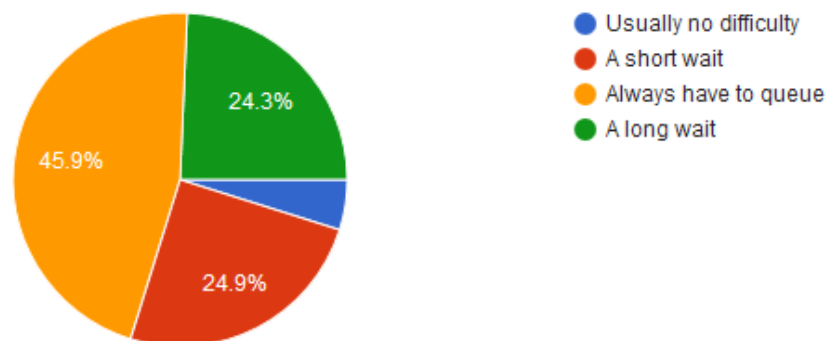
Which direction do you normally travel?

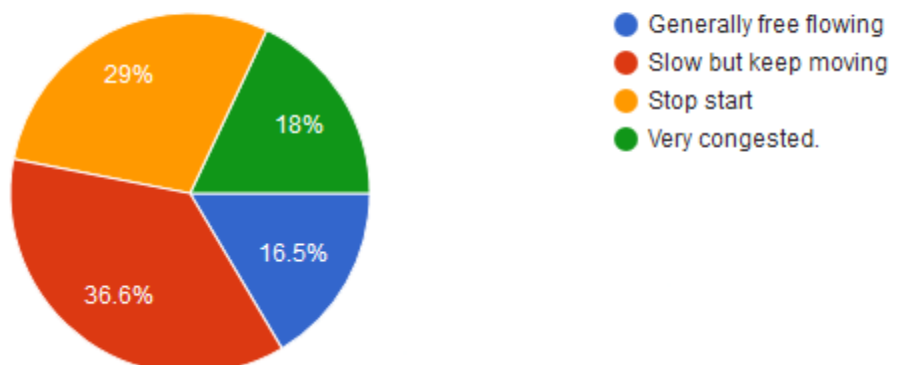
How difficult do you find it to access the A1079?

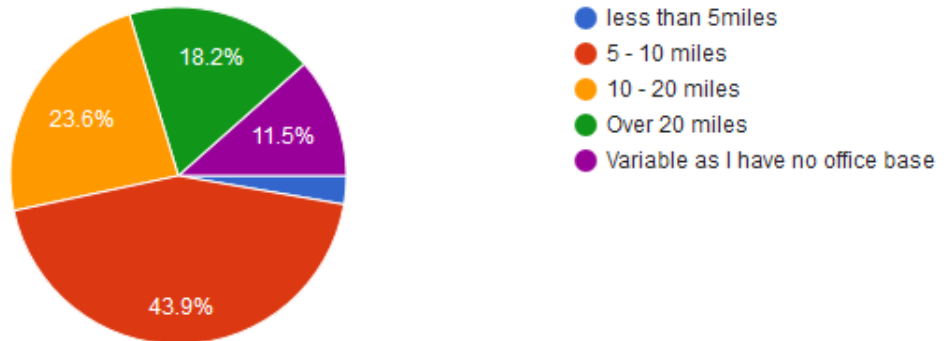
Once on the A1079 how do you find the traffic flow?

328 responses



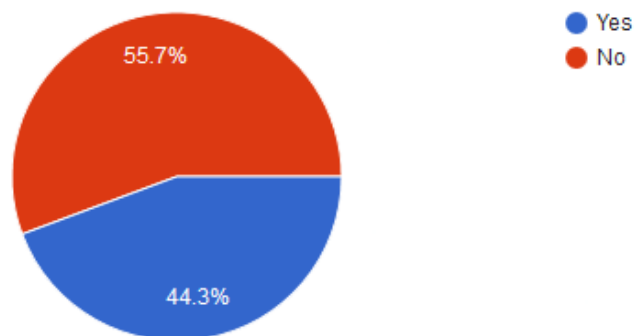
How far is your commute?

Summary of comments

145 of the 331 participants offered comments

The overall tenor of comments was of concern, frustration and a call for action.

85 suggested a roundabout would offer a solution

42 suggested traffic light would offer a solution

Some suggested nothing should be done

Some suggested action at Dunnington/Grimston Bar is needed.

Many of the comments referred to the situation as an accident waiting to happen. This is unfortunately exactly the current case. ERYC will take no action until there are "sufficient" death or serious injury incidents!
