3. Minutes of the Meeting of the Wilberfoss Parish Council held on 17th November 2016 were signed as a true record.

4 **Planning**

The Council considered Planning Application 16/04059/TPO | BIRKER LANE, WILBERFOSS - 1987 (REF:363) T1 & T5: Horse Chestnut x2; fell as dead and suffering from extensive crown die back | St John The Baptist Churchyard Beckside Wilberfoss East Riding Of Yorkshire YO41 5NS and had no observations to make.

The Council was notified that Planning Application PP-05530925 from Mr James Manners for the erection of a two storey extension to side, single storey extension to rear and construction of a pitched roof over existing flat roof canopy to front at 4 Paddock Close, Wilberfoss had been granted.

The Council was notified that Planning Application 16/03323/PLF | Erection of first floor extension and dormer window to front and construction of dormer extension to rear | 1 Willow Park Road Wilberfoss East Riding Of Yorkshire YO41 5PS had been approved. Approval was given subject to obscure glass being fitted in the rear dormer window.

The Council considered Planning Application 16/03609/PLF | Erection of an extension to the side with accommodation within the roof space | 26 Park Lane Wilberfoss East Riding Of Yorkshire YO41 5PW and had no observations to make.

The Council considered Planning Application 16/04049/TPO TPO HOLLYDENE, HULL ROAD & NO.S 29,31 & 33 BECKSIDE, WILBERFOSS - 1991 (REF:401) T5: Horse Chestnut: fell due to extensive bleeding canker and evidence of Honey fungus. | Hollydene Hull Road Wilberfoss East Riding Of Yorkshire YO41 5NT and had no observations to make.
