We look forward to our next event on Sep 12/13, when visitors will be able to see the garden again in a different season, in the early stages of autumn. Following this year's Annual Parish Council meeting we are pleased to advise that the Chair and Vice Chair have duly been appointed for the coming year. Lesley Hoyer will remain in her post as Chairman and David Smith will again take on the role of Vice Chairman.

Thank you to those of you who have supplied us with information of recent accidents. We would now like to collect details of historic accidents and would be grateful for details of any that you have either been involved in trying to use the A1079 at either of the Wilberfoss junctions, or ones that you have witnessed. Please send details to sarah-wills@supanet.com. Thank you - we will keep pushing for improvements to the infrastructure along this route.

Still on traffic issues, can we ask all drivers who use Birker Lane to respect the fact that the road is regularly used by dog walkers and families and there is no footpath. Although the speed limit is 30 mph, often the road is occupied by parents and children and people walking their dogs. A number of residents have been in touch within the last few weeks to notify the Parish Council of near misses between vehicles and pedestrians on Birker Lane. Clearly this is very worrying. Please reduce your speed. Thank you.

Wilberfoss Hill, or Cherry Hill as it is known locally, is becoming increasingly littered with plastic bottles, cans and paper. Admittedly some of the debris is road planings left by the sub-contractors working for East Riding of Yorkshire Council and we have been in touch with Highways to request its removal but we are concerned that the increase in general litter is encouraging others to leave debris. Please either take your litter home or use the waste bin provided at the bottom of the hill.

WILBERFOSS TENNIS CLUB-SPRING BULLETIN - tennis coaching for juniors has continued through the winter months in Wilberfoss on Thursday evenings and Sunday afternoons, and club night (open to all-comers) on Wednesdays from 6pm has been active since April. Adult coaching on Wednesdays (9.30-11am) is a popular addition to the menu offered by the club. Wilberfoss is well represented in the various tennis leagues around the York area. There are 4 mixed teams (captained by Bev Tebbutt, Neil Pratt, Liz Walker and Mark Screeton), 2 men's teams (with skippers Darren Penrose and Charlie Dodds) and a women's team (coordinated by Gerry Screeton).
